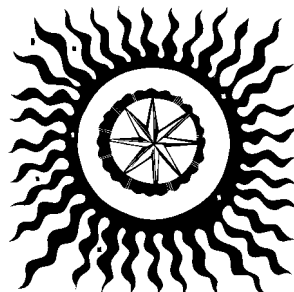
**Expenses: Plumbing repairs: \$447. Assessment: \$7000.
