**End of the month Budget (collections) for June**

**\$31,600** (\$7900 x 4 weeks) needed for the month (includes monthly tax assessment)

**\$32,190** was collected.

You will note a gain of \$590. in last month's budget needs. You will recall our parish council has requested a weekly increase of \$5.00 to meet this expense. A monthly donation of \$20.00 can be placed in the Diocesan Assessment envelope included in your budget envelopes. Registered parishioners may reserve up to two masses on weekends and two masses on weekdays until all requests are filled. Those who are not registered or from another parish may add names to the Sunday community mass at 10:30 AM.
