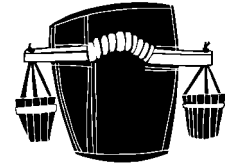

**NEW BEDFORD DEAN APPOINTED** - The Fall River Diocese is divided into five territorial districts or deaneries: Attleboro, Cape Cod, Fall River, New Bedford and Taunton. The Bishop appoints a Vicar Forane, also called a Dean, in each deanery to assist him in the promotion and coordination of apostolic and pastoral activity in that area. A Dean chairs a monthly meeting of the priests within his deanery; serves on the Presbyteral council (one of the two consulting bodies to the Bishop, undertake an annual visitation of the parishes of the Deanery in the name of the Bishop to examine the Sacramental registers and to inspect the parish properties), and to be available for the priests of the deanery for consultation. Bishop da Cunha has appointed me the new VF (Vicar Forane) of the New Bedford Deanery effective immediately until August 31, 2019. I am deeply grateful to Bishop da Cunha for his confidence in me by this appointment. With this appointment, you will see the canonical title change to Very Rev. Daniel W. Lacroix, VF, but I am still Fr. Dan!

**Education Assistance Envelope:** Its purpose is to fund the educational programs of our parish: retreats, informational items purchased, programs scheduled in our parish, etc. It also assists to fund salaries and stipends for our Coordinator and Director of our Religious Education Program. Likewise it covers any deficit in books, retreats, etc. provided for our religious education students, and assists those unable to pay the registration fee. Your generosity to this monthly collection greatly assists our community of Faith, especially our young people.
